

# **CALIFORNIA BASEBALL UMPIRES ASSOCIATION SOUTH BAY UNIT – Jerry Flory, Chairperson**

## **HALL OF FAME QUALIFICATIONS**

Umpire candidates must have demonstrated outstanding umpiring ability and dedication during their umpiring years with the South Bay Unit.

1. Must have umpired C.I.F. final at least once.
2. Must have umpired at least (10) play-off games
3. Umpires must have at least 10 years service in the South Bay Unit.
4. Umpires that do not meet the above qualifications and with at least 15 years of service who's dedication to umpiring in the South Bay Unit may be nominated.

## **NOMINATIONS**

Any South Bay Unit member in good standing may submit nominations. All nominations must be endorsed by the Board of Directors. All nominations must be in writing and must be in the hands of the Chairman of the Hall of Fame committee on or before March 15<sup>th</sup> to be considered during that year.

Nominations received after deadline will not be considered until the following year.

Written information must be submitted on the nominee, see below:

1. Candidate biographical information
2. Statistics in support of the nominees qualifications

## **ELECTION**

Election of new members will be made at a Board of Director's meeting, chaired by the Hall of Fame committee chairman prior to the May playoff meeting.

No more than five (5) nominees for consideration may be submitted.

No more than two (2) nominees may be elected each year.

There may be years when no one qualifies

## **INDUCTION**

The selected two (2) members will be inducted into the Hall of Fame at the annual playoff meeting.

A plaque will be presented to each new member commemorating his or her membership in the California Baseball Umpires Association, South Bay Unit, Hall of Fame.
